

Criteria for determining student's award amount

The NHSC Financial Assistance Office establishes standard institutional budgets, which reflect average costs for students during an academic year (9 months) or a twelve-month period, as appropriate.

Budgets established by the NHSC Financial Aid Office include "Direct Educational Expenses" such as tuition, fees, books and supplies and also include "Indirect Educational Expenses" such as housing, food, transportation and some personal costs. Students need to request and document Child Care Expenses before their budgets will reflect those allowable costs.
