

Requirements for the Return to Title IV Funds

The return to Title IV Funds, or R2T4's, is the return of government funds unused by a student due to their incompleting of course work during any given semester. If a student does not complete 60 percent of the semester, they are required by law to return a portion of the funds they have received that are equivalent to the amount of coursework they did not complete. If you are unsure if you owe any funds back, please see the NHSC Financial Aid administrators to determine whether you will need to return funds.

*The NHSC Financial Aid Office is responsible for calculating any return to IV funds. It is the responsibility of the student to visit the Financial Aid Office if they withdraw from classes at any time during the academic semester.
