Nueta Hidatsa Sahnish College to offer new Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration and Management

New Town, N.D. – Nueta Hidatsa Sahnish College (NHSC) has recently received approval from the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) to offer a brand new Bachelor in Arts program. A Bachelor in Arts in Business Administration and Management will be its newest addition to their offerings in Bachelor degrees. The College offers 14 Associates degrees, 4 Bachelor’s degrees and 3 Certificate programs.

The College plans to offer the new program starting in Spring 2023 and will look into offering concentrations to the program within the next three years. The approval of the new program will help NHSC and the Mandan, Arikara and Hidatsa tribes since many of the NHSC’s Business students go on to work for the MHA Nation.

President Baker stated, “Getting the bachelor’s in business program approved has been a long-time goal of our college, as it is our most popular two-year degree. After years of work, we are so gratified to reach this point. I am deeply proud of our faculty and staff who put in so much time and effort to make this happen. Few people outside of academia really know the work it takes to put together a new degree program, so we are quite excited to see a positive outcome. Having another program available close to home is one more way we are serving our Tribal Nation, our region, and the state.”

NHSC offers in-demand certificate programs and associate degrees as well as three bachelor’s degrees. The college offers high-quality cultural, academic, and vocational education. NHSC provides encouragement and support to facilitate successful college careers.
