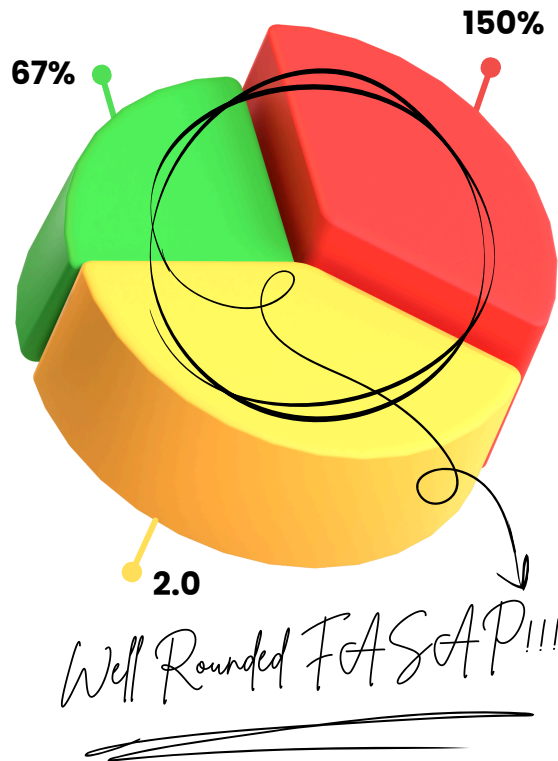
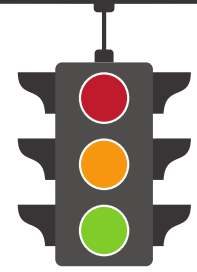


FINANCIAL AID

SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS



150% Time Frame

Students must complete their degree within 150% of the credit hours required for their program

Example: if your degree requires 60 credits to complete, you are given 90 credit hours to complete

2.0 GPA

Students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA each term

For a student to obtain a GPA of 2.0 or better, strive for a C or better in all courses

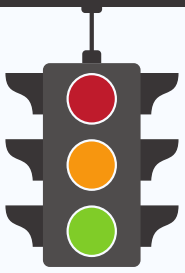
67% Completion

Students must pass & complete 67% of their semester & overall credit hours attempted

Beware of withdrawing or failing classes! These events will affect financial aid eligibility. Withdrawn and failed courses will count towards students attempted credit hours.

FASAP Warning & Suspension statuses will be communicated to students via email each semester.

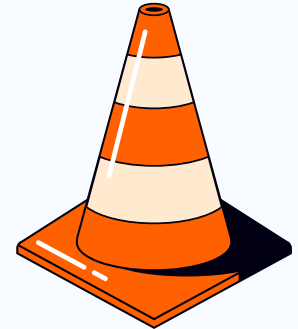
